## Memorandum of Understanding

This agreement is made on 11-Mar-2022 between **Data Science Lab Consulting Pvt Ltd** located at 19 Kohinoor Corner, Bhau Patil Road, Pune-20 (hereinafter referred to as 'DSL') and **Annasaheb Magar Mahavidyalaya** located at Hadapsar, Pune-28 (hereinafter referred to as 'Partner Institution').

DSL proposes to run a student mentorship program at the Partner Institution for first year Master of Computer Science students. 3. Provide a classroom for student interaction for a total of 8 hours in a week.
4. Provide computer with internet connection to the students.

DSL shall

1. Provide a detailed course curriculum to be completed in 1 year.
2. Provide experienced mentors to help selected students complete the course work.
3. Establish a process of continuous evaluation in agreement with the Partner Institution faculty. The evaluation would be carried out through assignments and projects, and DSL would award the grades to the participating students for respective courses.
4. Make a suitable full job offer after completing this course. The offered candidates are expected to work with DSL for at least 18 months after completion of their graduation.

- 2.2 Both institutions shall endeavour to organize joint seminars, colloquium and other academic and outreach programs;
- 2.3 Annasaheb Magar Mahavidyalaya and TOXINDIA shall apply for collaboration projects jointly to National and International funding agencies.
- 2.4 Both institutions shall endeavour to exchange relevant information related to proposed research work.

## ARTICLE III: GENERAL CONDITIONS

- b) Neither Party nor its personnel shall be considered as an official, employee, representative or joint partner of the other Party. Neither Party shall enter into contract or any other agreement on behalf of the other Party.
- c) Any activity to be taken up shall be completed within a stipulated time as agreed upon by the Parties.
- d) This MOU will provide the foundation and framework for later particular project(s)/program(s), developed by academic and administrative units/departments of both Parties for which a separate MOU will be signed.
- e) This MOU sets forth the intentions of the Parties to foster collaboration and cooperation in areas of mutual interests without legally binding commitments. If both Parties later agree to undertake specific joint projects with legally binding obligations, separate written agreements for such project(s) shall be made with mutual consent on each Party's contributions, responsibilities, and financial implications.

### I. MODE OF OPERATION

- a) Each Party shall designate a coordinator or a group of persons for coordinating and carrying out any activity of mutual interest.



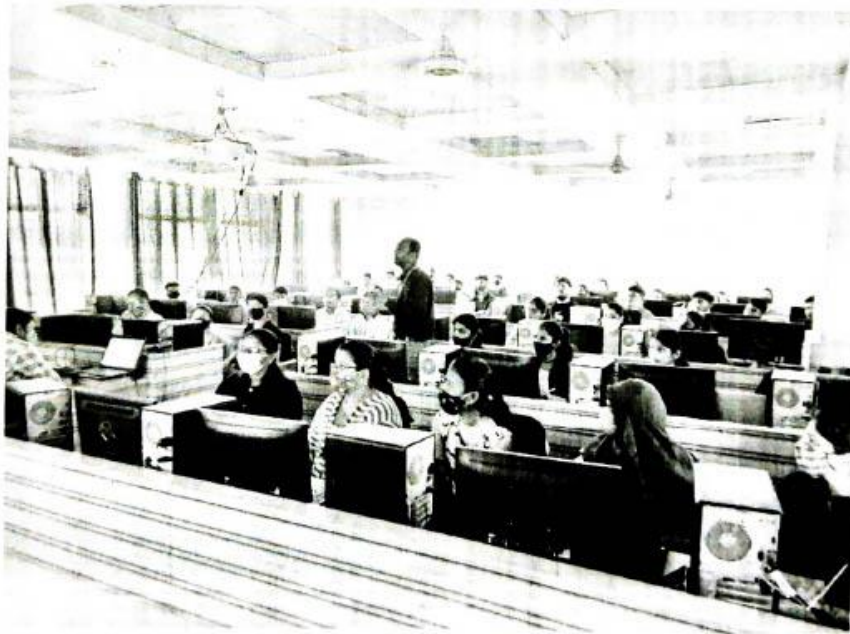

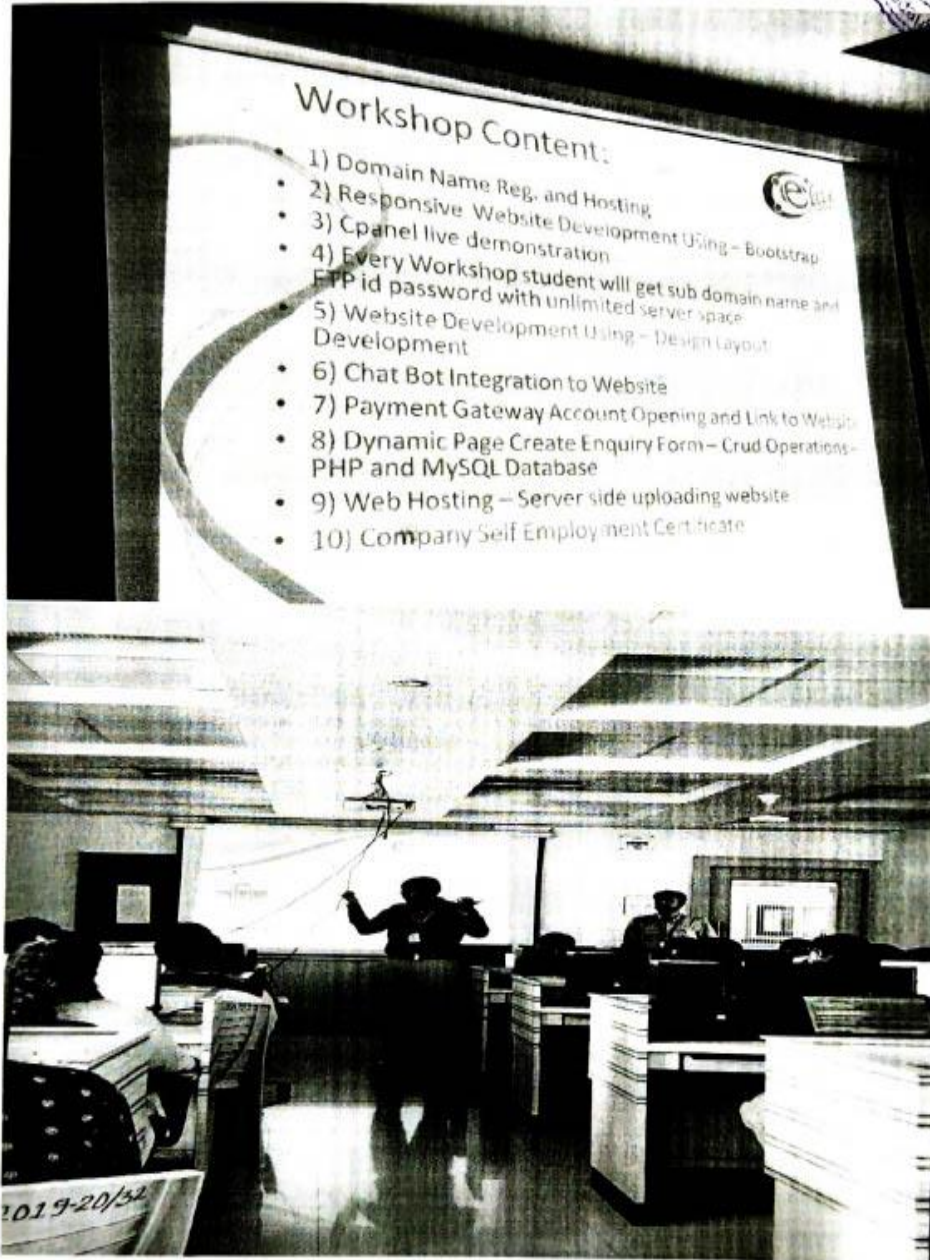

pronouncement having the force of law as may be issued and as may be in force from time to time.

- 1.2 **Confidential Information** shall mean such proprietary information or data of either Party which is not available in the public domain and is considered to be confidential by its very nature.
  - 1.3 **Intellectual Property Rights** shall mean all worldwide intellectual property rights, including without limitation, copyrights, trademarks, service marks, know-how and all other proprietary rights, whether registered or unregistered.
  - 1.4 **MOU** shall mean this MOU, together with its Annexures, as may be supplemented, amended, restated or replaced from time to time in accordance with this MOU.
  - 1.5 **Term** shall have the meaning ascribed to it in clause 3.
- 2) **Scope:** The Parties have entered into this MOU on a non-exclusive basis in order to carry out such responsibilities, as more particularly detailed in Annexure A of this MOU. Either Party may terminate this MOU for convenience by providing a written notice of thirty (30) days to the other Party. Without prejudice to any other rights and remedies available to it hereunder or at law, QHF may at its sole discretion terminate this MOU immediately upon providing written notice to the Institute if the Institute is in breach of its obligations hereunder and such breach is not cured within seven (07) days from notice of receipt by QHF informing about such breach. Upon termination or expiry of this MOU, both the Parties will be relieved of their obligations save such liabilities that accrue prior to the termination or expiry of this MOU.
  - 4) **Representations and Warranties:** Each of the Parties represents and warrants that it has the capacity to enter into this MOU and perform this MOU and all activities contemplated herein.
  - 5) **Confidentiality:** Any information exchanged between the Parties, which is of proprietary and confidential nature, whether or not marked as such, will be treated as Confidential Information. The Parties will protect and maintain the secrecy of Confidential Information exchanged between them and shall disclose the Confidential Information only to its authorized personnel on a need to know basis. Either Party will send a reasonable prior written intimation to the other Party in the event either Party intends to make any public release / statement with regard to this MOU and / or matters contemplated herein.
  - 6) **Intellectual Property Rights:** Each Party is the sole and exclusive owner of its Intellectual Property Rights and will not dispute the ownership in Intellectual Property Rights of the other Party. The Parties will seek each other's prior written approval in the event one Party seeks access to the intellectual property of the other Party. The approval to such access, if granted, will be solely for the purposes of this MOU and will not be construed as any transfer of ownership or grant of license.
  - 7) **Indemnity:** Each Party will indemnify the other Party from and against third party claim or loss of direct nature arising out of such Party's breach of the provisions of this MOU.

- 8) **Limitation of Liability:** TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, IN NO EVENT WILL EITHER PARTY HAVE ANY LIABILITY TO THE OTHER PARTY FOR ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECULATIVE, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS MOU. The total aggregate liability of one Party towards the other Party will not in any event exceed the sums actually incurred by the Party so liable in performing its respective obligations hereunder.
- 9) **Governing Law and Jurisdiction:** This MOU will be governed by the laws of India. The Parties submit themselves to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Pune, India.
- 10) **Force Majeure:** Neither Party will be liable for failure to perform its obligations during any period if performance is delayed or rendered impracticable or impossible due to circumstances beyond that Party's reasonable control.

## QuickHeal Foundation Report 2021 - 2022



**ABSTRACT:** The recently introduced term “Funga” is discussed in relation to its use in systematic and applied mycology. Arguments for and against the use of this term are considered. The modern system of fungi and fungus-like organisms is analyzed in connection with the problems of terminology. Several terminologically problematic groups (e.g., DRIP, Opisthosporidia, slime mold lineages, Oomycota, and labyrinthulids) are also discussed. Two alternatives to use of the term Funga are comprehensively analyzed. At the same time, several Funga-derived terms are outlined. In order for a new term to become mainstream, it is necessary to use this term when creating a classical multivolume monograph elaboration of fungal taxa in various countries.

#### I. INTRODUCTION

The present notice is intended to continue a discussion started on *IMA Fungus* pages with opening papers by Hawksworth<sup>1</sup> and Kuhar et al.,<sup>2</sup> who dedicated the proposal for wide use of the term “Funga.” They did this in order to substitute the term Mycobiota for Funga in fields where the term Flora (mycoflora) was previously used—that is, in a traditional field of biodiversity inventory and its biogeographic analysis as well as all of the applied fields. This problem is especially meaningful for fundamental works relevant in the long term, such as the creation of multivolume “Floras.”

A new direction set by Knudsen and Vesterholt,<sup>3</sup> who introduced the term Funga, was enthusiastically followed by some authors.<sup>4</sup> However, it is clear that the implementation of this proposal would face difficulties due to some avoidance of this term by authors for various reasons. Below, we will consider some possible reasons of this nature.

#### II. FUNGA: PRO ET CONTRA

The main arguments in favor of the term Funga are listed below:

- Fungi are traditionally considered as a separate kingdom of eukaryotes and require a separate general biological and related terminological approach.
- Fungi, plants, and animals are the most diverse groups of multicellular organisms and, if the terms Flora and Fauna traditionally correspond to species assemblages of the former, then fungal species assemblages require some equally short term that carries a conceptual significance.
- The term Mycobiota is not entirely successful for its composite characteristics, while “biota” is usually understood as the upper limit of the division in the synecological aspect but not in the

biodiversity aspect (in botanical terminology, the analogue of the Mycobiota would be the vegetation, but not the Flora).

- The term Funga is consonant with the brevity, genus, and ending of the names Flora and Fauna, and together they form a good conceptual abbreviation (FF&F).

There clearly are arguments against the term Funga. Among them, the following should be highlighted primarily:

- Funga is a rather polysemantic word: in Portuguese, it means a “sniffing”; in Swahili, “closer”; and in urban areas of the United States, a “bad man.” Funga is not purely a Latin word and is in fact also composite (the ending is unified in the manner of Flora and Fauna).
- Unlike such terms as Flora and Fauna, which are associated with a centuries-old tradition and refer to corresponding ancient deities, the term Funga is not rooted in ancient mythology, even though Kuhar et al.<sup>2</sup> associated it with goddess Diana. The term Diana seems to be more consistent with this logic, although it does not refer to any tradition either.
- A consequence of the rich history of the terms Flora and Fauna was the emergence of two main derivative terms, “floristic” and “faunistic” (including such subvariants as “algofloristic,” “mycofloristic,” “prostistofaunistic”). Taking the term Mycobiota as an example, it can be said that for almost 30 years of its existence, researchers were hesitant to design derivatives (“mycobiotic,” “mycobiotistics”) and, apparently, a similar fate threatens potential derivatives from the Funga term.
- The tradition to associate the plant world with Flora and the animal world with Fauna was a consequence of empirical evidence: multicellular animals were characterized by activity, whereas subjects of the plant world were characterized by their inability to change location. A review of the “plant world” polyphyly has not yet led to the development of special biodiversity-analytical and biogeographic terminology for each lineage, although many “plant” lineages are diverged from each other deeper than fungi from animals.

The last argument seems to be the most serious and deserves a more detailed consideration.

### III. KINGDOMS AND LINEAGES

Recent advances in eukaryote phylogenomics have yielded rather stable results, whereas against this backdrop, fewer researchers are resorting to such a category as “kingdom.” Usually, eukaryote groupings of the highest rank are called supergroups, whereas the branches above traditionally recognized phyla are considered as clades or lineages (e.g., opisthokonts). The term “kingdoms” is in current use among zoologists and mycologists, who do not need to coordinate the rank of these groups with a general eukaryote system, especially its upper divisions. Also, these specialists avoid inevitable ranks denominating internal subdivisions of such large units as Metazoa<sup>5</sup> and Fungi.<sup>6</sup> When mycologists keep Fungi on a kingdom rank in mycological works, this does not automatically lead to inflation of the rank of such groups as TSAR (telonemids + straminipiles + alveolates + rhizarians), or Discoba, since this lies beyond their field of competence. This is the reason why the two largest unions are firmly embedded in the mainstream on a kingdom rank, and it is difficult to imagine any changes to this doctrine. We are too focused on kingdoms since such taxon status drives researchers and science organizers to a certain “terminological separatism.”

Table 1 shows a distribution of “botanical” and “mycological” ecomorphs across the main eukaryote lineages.<sup>7-32</sup> As can be observed, a strict phylogenetic approach makes some remnants of the “plant world” orphans in the terminology field; in practice, florists and faunists each apply their own terminology to some of these orphans. If the term Flora were to be consistent with terminological separatism, it would be

Eukaryote supergroups are given according to the phylogenomic data.<sup>32</sup> Only supergroups that contain traditionally botanical and mycological subjects are listed here. The rest of the supergroups not presented here are the CRMs (colodictyomids + rhyfidids + *Manitamonas*), Hemimastigophora, and metamonads. A dash (—) means that the corresponding term has not been used in the known literature. An exclamation mark (!) means that the corresponding term for the designation of territorial species assemblages when considering this group has so far been avoided in use, but a separate term would be required in the case of orthodox "terminological separatism." A question mark (?) means that the corresponding group does not belong to the phylogenetic lineage known as "kingdom Fungi" but has been studied or is still being studied by mycological institutions and, in the case of avoiding the "Funga" term here, does not yet have any special term.

associated with the Archaeplastida lineage only; then territorial species assemblages in such supergroups as TSAR, Haptista, Cryptista, and Discoba would require several new terms, too.

Until now, the literature has avoided any terms for territorial species assemblages of some heterotrophic protists like *Rozella*, Aphelideae, and *Rhodolphis*.

Fungal ecomorphs lying outside groups such as Opisthosporidia, DRIP (*Dermocystidium* + rosette agent + *Ichthyophonus* + *Psorospermium*), and TSAR would not be covered using such a terminology separatism approach. The question of how to name territorial species assemblage in other lineages of eukaryotes traditionally studied by mycologists (Acrasiomycota, Myxomycota, Plasmodiophoromycota, Labyrinthulomycota, Oomycota, DRIP) also arises.

Discussion regarding the introduction of the term Funga therefore should inevitably touch upon certain terminological decisions affecting the lonely remnants of the “plant world” in the phylogenetic system of eukaryotes, including pseudofungi.

## IV. WHAT IS THE ALTERNATIVE?

The aforementioned terminological separatism approach requires at least the naming of the territorial species assemblages for the number of autotrophic and fungal TSAR groups, as well as the traditionally “algal” representatives of Euglenozoa. As far as we know, such attempts have not yet been made. If we do not use this option, then there are two alternatives for a mycologist: continue to use terms derived from Flora, or adhere to a faunistic terminology.

Flora-related terms applied to fungi correspond most with the evidence: the fungi are growing.<sup>33</sup> Historically, such a discourse has long stayed in the literature, since the majority of authors from the 17th–20th centuries have associated the fungi with plant organisms. For example, in Buxbaum’s *Plantarum Minus Cognitarum Centuria II*,<sup>34</sup> we can find some species of fungi among mosses and vascular plants.

The term “plant organism” represents a rather abstraction, an essential feature of which is the presence of a rigid cell wall. The main lines of progressive multicellularity from an ancestral nonmotile cell with a rigid wall are based on the superposition of linear aggregations of such cells (the filaments), whereas the parenchymatic (autotrophs) and plectenchymatic (fungi) histoarchitecture represents a limit of filament evolution. Regarding this aspect, the fungi seem to be more comparable with plants than with epithelial-mesenchymal metazoans. In particular, the flora-related terms have taken root in lichenology; because of their algal component, advanced lichenized fungi have thalli with morphogenetic polarization imitating those of autotrophic algae or mosses. Even in recent years when the term Mycobiota was recommended for the fungi, the term Lichen Flora continued to persist in mass lichenological literature.<sup>35</sup>

The second alternative (the use of fauna-related terms to fungi) seems to be not yet practically implemented (e.g., a Google query for “Mycofauna” yielded only 203 results), although in some very old systems the fungi were interpreted as the closest relatives of the sponges (the term Funga is etymologically related just to Spongia) or other “phytozoans.” For example, in the classification system by Professor Pavel Goryaninov (1796–1865), fungi and sponges were regarded as neighboring subdivisions of the “Phytozoa” division.<sup>36</sup> Phylogenetically, there is a sound basis for such juxtaposition: the opisthokonts clade (holozoa + holomycota) together with the clades of apusomonads and breviate form a single monophyletic grouping Obazoa,<sup>37</sup> all the basal lineages of which are presented by amoeboid protozoans. In such a hypothetical solution, the term Fauna of fungi (or Mycofauna) would be understood by analogy with a real-life concept of “sporozoan fauna.” In this connection, the ascomycete *Pneumocystis carinii* represents an interesting example, originally studied by parasitologists and protozoologists.<sup>38</sup>

## V. WHAT IS THE INTERNET LOOKING FOR?

Even though modern researchers avoiding a retrograde brand try to reject the term Mycoflora, giving preference to Mycobiota or Mycota, the term Mycoflora continues to be most relevant in Google search queries (Table 2), which can be interpreted as an inertial trend. The term Fauna, paradoxical in this situation, currently is not particularly accepted (203 results) and seems unlikely to be accepted in the future, because the majority of mycologists are associated with mycological or botanical, but not zoological, research institutions.

The terms Funga and Mycota are limited in our search queries, since they have more than one meaning. For example, in Portuguese texts, the word “funga” is mentioned 7,270,000 times, and in Swahili texts, 6,630,000 times; yet the word “mycota,” if it is not filtered with an exclusion of cream name and kingdom name, is found in the English segment of the Internet 297,000 times. With appropriate filtering, the term Mycota gives 145,000 results, whereas the term Funga yields only 68,000. Even these results do not seem absolutely explicit, but it is vital to understand the importance of the possible promotion of a new term and obstacles in overcoming conservative mainstream trends. Whether the new term will be able to overcome this “thermal motion” strongly depends on its involvement in Web projects that could contribute to its “shooting.” We are aware of two major biodiversity projects that can potentially promote the Funga term:

- MIND.Funga: Monitoring and Inventorying Neotropical Diversity of Fungi (<https://mindfunga.ufsc.br/o-projeto/?lang=en>)
- Funga of Russia (<https://www.inaturalist.org/projects/funga-of-russia>)

Both of these projects are actively in development at the current time.

## VI. OVERCOMING A CAUTION

To overcome conservative tendencies, promotion of the term Funga would not be sufficient in action. Additionally, it seems necessary to introduce Funga-related terms in current use in floristic analytic studies. Below are the basic Funga derivatives, which would be logical to recommend for current use of all the adherents of the term in question:

- Fungarium: a substitute for botanical “herbarium” (Hawksworth<sup>1</sup>)
- Fungistics: a substitute for botanical “floristics” (e.g., “methods of fungistics,” “comparative fungistics”)

- Fungistic: a substitute for botanical “floristic” (e.g., “fungistic analysis,” “ecological fungistic elements”)
- Fungoanalytical: a substitute for botanical “floroanalytical” (e.g., “fungoanalytical methods”)
- Fungagenesis: a substitute for botanical “florogenesis”
- Fungacoenotic: a substitute for botanical “florocoenotic” (e.g., “fungacoenotic complexes”)
- Fungoid: a substitute for botanical “floroid” (i.e., obviously incomplete flora) (e.g., “fungoid obtained during a foray”)
- Paleofunga: a substitute for botanical “paleoflora” (e.g., “Eocene paleofunga”)

In conclusion, it should be noted that mainstream changes are as a rule unpredictable. Even logically sustained terminological systems can be incapable of overcoming mass views, whereas some paradoxical terms and concepts achieve unconditionally wide acceptance. A rather long transitional period awaits, during which Funga, Mycobiota, Mycoflora, and perhaps terms based on them, will compete. One day, however, “Funga” may emerge as the basic term covering fungi and fungal analogues, rather than the kingdom Fungi, for the broader historically-rooted union. I would, however, like to see “Funga” increasingly adopted by mycologists for treatments of the fungi in particular regions, especially for major books and any new multi-volume series, where “Flora” would otherwise have been used.

### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
