Rules and Regulations for Credit and Semester System in Post-Graduate Departments of the University w.e. f. Academic Year 2018-2019

I. General Administration of the Credit & Semester System

1. There shall be a coordination committee for Credit & Semester system, with Pro-Vice-Chancellor as its chairperson, consisting of not less than three Professors and two Associate/Assistant Professors from Teaching Departments across faculties. This committee will, from time to time, take appropriate policy decisions regarding the functioning of the Credit & Semester system and give instructions to the Examination Section, PG Admission Section, IT Cell and the academic departments on the campus. All matters regarding the conduct of Credit & Semester System shall be referred to this Coordination Committee for decision. Ordinarily, the duration of this Committee shall be for three years.
2. Any issues arising out of the implementation of the Credit and Semester System which are of a specific nature relating to any particular department shall be resolved by the concerned Departmental Committee and reported to the Coordination Committee.
3. The Coordination Committee shall from time to time consider suggestions received from, faculty, students and the examination section and wherever the matter pertains to the overall functioning of the Credit and Semester System, shall recommend new rules, modifications in the existing rules or clarifications thereof.

II. Admission and Conduct of the Credit System

1. Postgraduate courses are conducted under four different faculties, viz. Humanities, Science and Technology, Commerce and Management and Interdisciplinary faculty and the requirement of credits to be completed for degree courses under each of these faculties is different.
2. The M.A. degree (Humanities) will be awarded to students who complete a total of 64 credits in a minimum of two years by completing on an average 16 credits per semester. The M.Sc. degree (Science and Technology) will be awarded to students who complete a total of 80 credits (120 credits; 200 credits; 240 credits) in a minimum of two (three; five; six) years by completing on an average 20 credits per semester. The M.Tech. degree (Science and Technology) will be awarded to students who complete a total of 70 (72) credits in a minimum of two years as per the AICTE guidelines by completing on an average 17-18 credits per semester. For the postgraduate degrees from Commerce and Management Faculties and the Interdisciplinary Faculty, the requisite number of credits that need to be completed in the minimum duration are specified in Table 1.

3. Except practical credits wherever applicable, students may be allowed to complete less courses per semester on a condition they complete the two-year degree in a maximum of four years, a three year degree in a maximum of five years, a five year degree in a maximum of seven years and a six year degree in a maximum of eight years. This facility will be available subject to the availability of concerned courses in a given semester.
4. A student may opt for courses equivalent to 25 percent credits from any other department than the one where he/she is registered. In case a student wishes to take all courses from the parent department he/she can also do so.
5. Of the 75 percent credits to be earned from the parent department, student is expected to successfully complete the core courses of the parent department to get the degree. For remaining credits he/she can choose courses from electives offered by the department.
6. Each credit will be equivalent to 15 clock hours of teaching.
7. The department can announce Seminar Courses to introduce students to recent advances in research. Seminar credits are to be conducted through discussion and presentation by the student and the personal guidance by the teacher. Seminars shall not exceed a maximum of two credits.
8. Each department should decide the minimum eligibility for all the credits including the seminar credits.
9. The duly constituted Departmental Committee consisting of teachers in the department
 - a. will nominate the faculty for each course to be taught in the department;
 - b. will approve the plan for the evaluation prepared by the faculty for the credits concerned as internal continuous assessment of 50 percent from among the nine options given in the III.12 below. Ordinarily the teacher may opt for an internal assessment procedure other than written exams;
 - c. will evolve the norms for evaluating oral examinations whenever necessary in relation to term paper/assignments;
 - d. will constitute the Departmental Examination Committee (DEC) that will nominate the faculty concerned as the paper setter and examiner for the semester-end examination (50 percent component);
 - e. will decide eligibility norms for students from other departments opting for the courses at the department;
 - f. will identify the core credits that a student registered in the department must necessarily earn to obtain a post-graduate degree in that subject;
 - g. will announce at the commencement of each semester which credits are available to students from other departments;

- h. will take appropriate decisions in the cases of readmissions of students during transition from old to revised syllabus by deciding which credits from the revised syllabus are equivalent to credits from the old syllabus;
 - i. will revise the syllabus at least every three years;
10. Regular Students can also audit courses if the departmental committee agrees. A student must, at the commencement of the semester communicate which credits he/she is going to audit. Students can also audit courses from other departments with prior approval from that department. Such audited credits will be mentioned separately in the grade sheet. For audit course, student will have to pay tuition fees however he/she will not be evaluated.
11. Regular students can take extra credit courses from their own department or from other departments. In such cases, students shall specify the extra credits and this will be so noted on their grade sheets. The CGPA of a student will be computed on the basis of
- a. his/her performance in the core courses from parent department
 - b. best performance of the required no. of credits from all elective courses opted by him/her.
11. University departments will also permit students to be admitted as casual students (students who may not be currently registered as PG students on the campus) and enroll themselves for the courses being conducted by the departments in the respective semesters. Casual students will have to pay the tuition fees. In case, these students wish to receive a certificate for the completion of the course, they will be evaluated after payment of the examination fee for the corresponding subject.
12. Students may opt for credits from diploma/certificate credit courses offered by the university departments as elective credits.

III. EXAMINATION RULES

1. A student cannot appear for semester end examination unless he/she has maintained 75% attendance during the teaching period of that course. If a student fails to maintain attendance upto 75%, at the time of filling of examination forms, an undertaking from the student should be taken stating that he/she will be permitted to appear for examination subject to fulfillment of required attendance criteria during the remaining period of teaching of the course.
2. Each credit will be evaluated for 25 marks.
3. Each course will have

- a. 50% of marks as semester-end examination of minimum 30 minutes to maximum 45 minutes per credit and
 - b. 50% marks for internal (i.e. in-semester) assessment.
4. To pass a course, the student has to obtain forty percent marks in the combined examination of in-semester assessment and semester-end assessment with a minimum of thirty percent in both these separately.
 5. If a student misses an internal assessment examination in the Semester, he/she will have a second chance with the permission of the teacher concerned.
 6. In case student fails in internal assessment he/she can still be permitted to appear for Semester End Examination. However, final result of such student would be "Failed" in that subject.
 7. Such student can attempt to clear his/her internal and end semester examination by registering for the course in the semester when the course is offered by the concerned department.

A student who has cleared internal assessment but failed in semester end examination and who wants to improve his/her performance in the internal assessment, may be permitted to register again for the course when that course is being offered.

Whenever student registers for the course he/she will have to pay tuition fees.

Department Heads shall inform to IT Cell regarding such students so that the students would be able to pay tuition fees.

8. Students who have cleared the Internal Assessment but have failed in the Semester-End Exam may reappear for the Semester-End Exam in the subsequent period. The student will be finally declared as failed if he/she does not earn all required credits within a total period of four years in case of two year courses, five years in case of three year courses, seven years in case of five year courses, and eight years in case of six year courses. After that, such students will have to seek fresh admission as per the admission rules prevailing at that time if they wish to continue.
9. A student cannot register for the third semester, if he/she fails to complete 50% credits of the total credits expected to be ordinarily completed within the first two semesters. In this case, a student can seek admission to first or second semester in order to complete the requisite number of credits and to be able to seek admission in the third semester. Information regarding such students should be sent to PG section so that IT cell can be informed to open the form for paying tuition fees.
10. There shall be revaluation of the answer scripts of semester-end examination but not of internal assessment papers as per Ordinance no 134 A and B. While marks will be given

for all examinations, they will be converted into grades. The semester end and final grade sheets and transcripts will have only grades and grade points average.

11. Except for the technology faculty, in subjects or departments where project work is part of the credits, the project will consist of not more than ten percent of the total credits for the degree course.
12. Each credit will have an internal (continuous) assessment of 50% of marks and a teacher must select a variety of procedures for examination such as:
 - a. Written Test and/or Mid Term Test (not more than one for each course);
 - b. Term paper;
 - c. Journal/lecture/library notes;
 - d. Seminar presentation;
 - e. Short quizzes;
 - f. Assignments;
 - g. Extension work;
 - h. Research Project by individual students or group of students
 - i. Open book test (with the concerned teacher deciding what books are to be allowed for this purpose.)
13. The system of evaluation will be as follows: Each assignment/test will be evaluated; marks of all internal assessments would be compiled to generate the final score of internal assessment. For every course, the score for internal assessment and the semester-end examination will be added together and then converted into a grade and a grade point average. Results will be declared for each semester and the final grade-sheet will give total grades and grade point as per the table given below.

14. Cumulative Grade Point Average =

n = Total number of courses

P_i = Grade points earned in i^{th} course

C_i = Number of credits in i^{th} course

15. The formula for CGPA will be based on weighted average as mentioned above. The final CGPA will not be printed unless a student passes courses equivalent to the requisite number of credits for the concerned degree.
16. A ten point grade system [UGC Circular, vide D. O. No. F. 1- 1/2014 (Secy) dated 12th November, 2014] will be followed uniformly for all the four faculties. The corresponding grade table is detailed below.

17. If the CGPA is higher than the indicated upper limit in the three decimal digits, then the student be awarded higher final grade (e.g. a student getting CGPA of 8.492 may be awarded 'A+' grade).
18. While declaring the FINAL result, ordinances O2 (grace for getting a higher grade) and O4 (grace marks for passing in case a student has failed in only one head of passing) are applicable. There is also a provision for verification and revaluation. In case of verification, the existing rules will be applicable. The revaluation result will be adopted if there is a change of at least 10% marks and in the grade of the course.
19. The formula for conversion of CGPA to percentages is given in the following table.

20. For grade improvement a student will have to take minimum 30% of the requisite number of credits for the concerned degree. These courses will be theory courses from the parent department. A student can opt for the grade improvement programme only after the declaration of the result for his/her final semester exam, and within two years of completion of the degree and only once.
21. The explanation of the grades is provided below.

O: Outstanding: Excellent analysis of the topic (80% and above)

Accurate knowledge of the primary material, wide range of reading, logical development of ideas, originality in approaching the subject, Neat and systematic organization of content, elegant and lucid style;

A+ : Excellent : Excellent analysis of the topic (70 to 79%)

Accurate knowledge of the primary material, acquaintance with seminal publications, logical development of ideas, Neat and systematic organization of content, effective and clear expression;

A: Very Good: Good analysis and treatment of the topic (60 to 69%)

Almost accurate knowledge of the primary material, acquaintance with seminal publications, logical development of ideas, Fair and systematic organization of content, effective and clear expression;

B+: Good: Good analysis and treatment of the topic (55 to 59%)
Basic knowledge of the primary material, logical development of ideas, Neat and systematic organization of content, effective and clear expression;


B: Above Average: Some important points covered (50 to 54%)
Basic knowledge of the primary material, logical development of ideas, Neat and systematic organization of content, good language or expression;

C: Average: Some points discussed (45 to 49%)
Basic knowledge of the primary material, some organization, acceptable language or expression;

P: Pass: Any two of the above (40 to 44%)

F: Fail: None of the above (0 to 39%)

22. Every student registered for PG course has to pass ten credits (Human rights education - 2 credits; Cyber security- 4 credits; Skill development- 4 credits) as per UGC rules. Performance in these credits will not be considered for calculation of CGPA.
23. Payment of examination fees: Examination fees should be paid online as per the Challan generated in the system.



1. Background/Preamble:

Education plays enormously significant role in building of a nation. There are quite a large number of educational institutions, engaged in imparting education in our country. Majority of them have entered recently into semester system to match with international educational pattern. However, our present education system is churning out youth who have to compete locally, regionally, nationally as well as globally. The present alarming situation necessitates transformation and/or redesigning of system, not only by introducing innovations but developing learner-centric approach.

Majority of Indian higher education institutions have been following the system which obstructs the flexibility for the students to study the subjects/courses of their choice and their mobility to different institutions. There is need to allow the flexibility in education system, so that students depending upon their interests can choose inter-disciplinary, intra-disciplinary and skill-based courses. This can only be possible when choice based credit system (CBCS), an internationally acknowledged system, is adopted. The choice based credit system not only offers opportunities and avenues to learn core subjects but also explore additional avenues of learning beyond the core subjects for holistic development of an individual. The CBCS will undoubtedly facilitate benchmarking of our courses with best international academic practices.

1.1 Preface

In a bid to fine tune our scientific education system to the global standards & practices, the Credit-Grade based performance and assessment system will be implemented with effect from June 2019 onwards for all the Under Graduate Programmes (UG) under the Faculty of Science, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune, starting with First Year.

With the advent of frontier science, technology and ever-changing expectations from the Industry and Society, it has become imperative to relook at the structure and subject contents of various UG courses to make it contemporary and relevant.

As per the decision by the authorities of Savitribai Phule Pune University, the faculty of Science has prepared the choice based credit system and its structure. The revised course is of 132 credits and 1 credit is equivalent to 15 hours. Assessments in credit system consist of A) In-semester continuous assessment and B) End-semester assessment for the Theory head and Term Work/ Practical / Oral / Presentation at the end of the semester for Practical, Oral, Seminar and Project Head.

The faculty of Science has shouldered the idea of incorporating latest advances in Science and technology and equip the subject/syllabus contents with latest and relevant topics and know-hows. Accordingly the new structure and syllabi are being introduced, to be implemented from the academic year 2019-20 from First Year and it will continue for subsequent years.

1. All UG programmes, under Faculty of Science shall be offered with credit system.
2. All the B.Sc. programmes running under the Faculty of Science will be of three years duration.
3. The total no. of credits required for the completion of the programme is 132 credits.
4. One credit is equivalent to 15 hours.
5. A student is required to earn 132 credits in a minimum period of six semesters.
6. There are eight mandatory credits to be earned by the students for the award of degree.
7. Final CGPA will be calculated on the basis of 132 credits.
8. There is 15 weeks of teacher-student interaction during the semester.
9. The 15 week is divided into 12 weeks teaching and 3 weeks for continuous assessment including preparation time to students during the semester.

10. The workload will be calculated on the basis of 12 weeks teaching only.

1.2 Advantages of the choice based credit system:

1. Shift in focus from the teacher-centric to student-centric education.
2. Student may undertake as many credits as they can cope with (without repeating all courses in a given semester if they fail in one/more courses).
3. CBCS allows students to choose inter-disciplinary, intra-disciplinary courses, skill oriented papers (even from other disciplines according to their learning needs, interests and aptitude) and more flexibility for students.
4. CBCS makes education broad-based and at par with global standards. One can take credits by combining unique combinations. For example, Physics with Economics, Microbiology with Chemistry or Environment Science etc.
5. CBCS offers flexibility for students to study at different times and at different institutions to complete one course (ease mobility of students). Credits earned at one institution can be transferred to another institution.

1.3 Implementation of UG course structure:

1. For First year: Student has to select 4 different subject among the subjects offered by the College /Institute.
2. For Second year: Student has to select 3 different subject among 4 subject chosen in first year
3. For Third year: Student has to select only 1 subject among the 3 subject opted in second year
4. CGPA will be calculated on the basis of core 132 credits only
5. Each theory credit is equivalent to 15 clock hours of teaching and each practical credit is equivalent to 30 clock hours of teaching in a semester.
6. There is 15 weeks of teacher-student interaction during the semester.
7. The 15 week is divided into 12 weeks teaching and 3 weeks for continuous assessment including preparation time to students during the semester.
8. The workload will be calculated on the basis of 12 weeks teaching only.
9. For the purpose of computation of work-load the following mechanism may be adopted as per UGC guidelines:
 - i) 1 Credit = 1 Theory period of one hour fifteen minute duration per week
 - ii) 1 Credit = 1 Tutorial period of one hour fifteen minute duration per week
 - iii) 1 Credit = 1 Practical period of two hour ten minute duration per week
10. Each theory Lecture time for FY,SY,TY is of 50 min. (3 Lectures per week for 2 credit course)
11. Each practical session time for FY is of 3 hour 15 minutes = 195 min
12. Each practical session time for SY & TY is of 4 hour 20 minutes = 260 min
13. Exam pattern: University assessment 70 % and continuous internal assessment 30 %.
14. For Internal examination minimum two tests per paper of which one has to be written test of 10 marks.
15. Methods of assessment for Internal exams: Seminars, Viva-voce, Projects, Surveys, Field visits, Tutorials, Assignment, Group Discussion.

2. UG Programme Structure:

2.1 Each B.Sc. programme is of 3 years duration. The minimum total no. of credits requirement for each programme is 132. In the structure, the credits are distributed over 6 semesters. The open elective included, gives the student a wide choice of subjects from other programmes. The Credit structure for B.Sc. programme is given below in Table 1.

Table 1: Credit structure for B.Sc. programme (faintly visible text)

1. The first year duration is 12 months and is divided into two semesters of 6 months each.

2. The second year duration is 12 months and is divided into two semesters of 6 months each.

3. The third year duration is 12 months and is divided into two semesters of 6 months each.

4. Each semester is divided into two halves of 3 months each.

5. Each half-year credit is equivalent to 1 credit hour of teaching and self-study work.

6. The total credit requirement for the B.Sc. programme is 132 credits.

7. The B.Sc. programme is a 3-year programme.

2.2 Mandatory Credit courses for award of B.Sc. Degree:

In addition to the compulsory credits of 132, the student has to earn additional 8 credits from following groups by taking/participating/conducting respective activities.

Courses in Group I are compulsory.

The student can earn maximum 04 credits from an individual group from Group 2 to Group -9.

These extra credits will not be considered for GPA calculation, however these are mandatory for the completion and award of B. Sc. Degree.

- Group 1:** Physical Education (at F. Y. B. Sc. Sem. I) -01 credit
Physical Education (at F. Y. B. Sc. Sem. II) - 01 credit
(Note: Group I is compulsory for all the students as stated above.)
- Group 2:** Sport representation at College level - 01 credit
Sport representation at University/Statelevel - 02 credits
- Group 3:** National Social Service Scheme (participation in Camp): 01 credits
N.C.C.(with participation in annual camp) -01 credit
N. C. C. (with B certificate/C certificate award)- 02 credits
N.S.S./N.C.C. Republic day parade participation - 04 credits
- Group 4:** Avishkar participation; Extension activity participation, Cultural activity participation -01 credit
Avishkar selection at University level - 02 credits
Avishkar winner at state level - 04 credits
- Group 5:** Research paper presentation at State/National level - 01credits
Research paper presentation at International level - 02 credits
- Group 6:** Participation in Summer school/programme; Short term course (not less than 1-week duration) - 03 credit.
- Group 7:** Scientific Survey, Societal survey, - 02 credits.
- Group 8:** Field Visits; Study Tours; Industrial Visits; Participation in curricular/ cocurricular competitions- 01 Credit.
- Group 9:** Online certificate Courses /MOOC Courses/ Career Advancement Course up to 04 credits (Minimum 10 Hrs. / credit)

2.3 Outlines of Choice Based Credit System [Detailed description of the courses]:

- a) **Core Course**(14 for honours courses; 4 discipline specific papers each for regular courses and 2 papers each for English and Hindi/MIL in B.A./B.Com): The papers under this category are going to be taught uniformly across all universities with 30% deviation proposed in the draft. The purpose of fixing core papers is to ensure that all the institutions follow a minimum common curriculum so that each institution/university adheres to common minimum standard. Also the course designed for papers under this category aim to cover the basics that a student is expected to imbibe in that particular discipline. A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a Core course.
- b) **Elective Course:** Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline/subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency/skill is called an Elective Course.
- i. **Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course**(4 for honours courses and 2 each for regular courses): Elective courses offered under the main discipline/subject of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective. The list provided under this category are suggestive in nature and each University has complete freedom to suggest their own papers under this category based on their expertise, specialization, requirements, scope and need. The University/Institute may also offer discipline related Elective courses of interdisciplinary nature (to be offered by main discipline/subject of study).
 - ii. **Dissertation/Project*:** An elective course designed to acquire special/advanced knowledge, such as supplement study/support study to a project work, and a candidate studies such a course on his own with an advisory support by a teacher/faculty member is called dissertation/project.
 - iii. **Generic Elective (GE) Course**(4 for honours courses and 2 each for B.A./B.Com. regular courses): An elective course chosen from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intention to seek exposure beyond discipline/s of choice is called a Generic Elective. The purpose of this category of papers is to offer the students the option to explore disciplines of interest beyond the choices they make in Core and Discipline Specific Elective papers. The list provided under this category are suggestive in nature and each University has complete freedom to suggest their own papers under this category based on their expertise, specialization, requirements, scope and need.
- P.S.: A core course offered in a discipline/subject may be treated as an elective by other discipline/subject and vice versa and such electives may also be referred to as Generic Elective.
- c) **Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC):** The Ability Enhancement (AE) Courses may be of two kinds: Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC). "AECC" courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement; i. Environmental Science and ii. English/MIL(Marathi/Hindi) Communication. These are mandatory for all disciplines. SEC courses are value-based and/or skill-based and are aimed at providing hands-on-training, competencies, skills, etc.

- i. **Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC):** Environmental Science, English Communication/Hindi Communication/MIL Communication.
 - ii. **Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)**(minimum 2 for honours courses and 4 for regular courses): These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based knowledge and should contain both theory and lab/hands-on/training/field work. The main purpose of these courses is to provide students life-skills in hands-on mode so as to increase their employability. The list provided under this category are suggestive in nature and each University has complete freedom to suggest their own papers under this category based on their expertise, specialization, requirements, scope and need.
- d) **Practical/tutorials** (One each with every core and discipline/generic specific elective paper): The list of practical provided is suggestive in nature and each university has the freedom to add/subtract/edit practical from the list depending on their faculty and infrastructure available. Addition will however be of similar nature.

e) **Introducing Research Component in Under-Graduate Courses**

Project work/Dissertation is considered as a special course involving application of knowledge in solving / analyzing /exploring a real life situation / difficult problem. A Project/Dissertation work would be of 6 credits. A Project/Dissertation work may be given in lieu of a discipline specific elective paper.

3. Eligibility for Admission:

3.1 First Year B.Sc.:


- A. Higher Secondary School Certificate (10+2) or its equivalent Examination with English and three science subjects such as Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, Geography, Geology, etc. OR
 - B. Three Years Diploma in Pharmacy Course of Board of Technical Education conducted by Government of Maharashtra or its equivalent. OR
 - C. Higher Secondary School Certificate (10+2) Examination with English and vocational subject of + 2 level (MCVC) - Medical Lab. Technician (Subject Code = P1/P2/P3)
- Admissions will be given as per the selection procedure / policies adopted by the respective college keeping in accordance with conditions laid down by the University of Pune.

Reservation and relaxation will be as per the Government rules.

3.2 Medium of Instruction: English

3.3 Award of Credits:

- Each course having 4 credits shall be evaluated out of 100 marks and student should secure at least 40 marks (40%) in continuous assessment as well as term end exam to earn full credits of that course.
- Each course having 3 credits shall be evaluated out of 75 marks as students should secure at least 30 marks (40%) in continuous assessment as well as term end exam to earn full credits of that course.



- Each course having 2 or 1.5 credits shall be evaluated out of 50 marks and student should secure at least 20 marks (40%) in continuous assessment as well as term end exam to earn full credits of that course.
- Each course having 1 credits shall be evaluated out of 25 marks as student shall secure 10 marks (40%) in continuous assessment as well as term end exam to earn full credits of that course.
- GPA shall be calculated based on the marks obtained in the respective subject provided that student should have obtained credits for that course. Structure of marks scheme for choice based credit system program is given in Table 2.



4. Evaluation Pattern:

- 4.1 The course carrying 100 marks shall be evaluated with Continuous Assessment (CA) and University Evaluation (UE) mechanism.
- 4.2 Continuous assessment shall be of 30 marks while University Evaluation shall be of 70 marks. To pass in a course of 4 credit, a student has to secure minimum 40 marks provided that he should secure minimum 28 marks in University Evaluation (UE) and 12 marks (40%) in continuous assessment.
- 4.3 The course carrying 50 marks shall be evaluated with Continuous Assessment (CA) and University Evaluation (UE) mechanism. Continuous assessment shall be of 15 marks while University Evaluation shall be of 35 marks.
- 4.4 To pass in a course of 2 or 1.5 credit, a student has to secure minimum 20 marks provided that he/she should secure minimum 14 marks in University Evaluation (UE) and 6 marks (40%) in continuous assessment.
- 4.5 For Internal examination minimum two tests per paper of which one has to be a written test 10 Marks
- 4.6 Methods of assessment for Internal exams: Seminars, Viva-voce, Projects, Surveys, Field visits, Tutorials, Assignment, Group Discussion, etc (on approval of the head of the centre)
- 4.7 There shall be revaluation of the answer scripts of semester-end examination of theory papers only but not of internal assessment papers as per Ordinance no 134 A and B.

5. ATKT Rules:

- 5.1 Minimum number of credits required to take admission to Second Year of B. Sc.: 31 [70%]
- 5.2 Minimum number of credits required to take admission to Third Year of B.Sc.: 44 credits [100%] to be completed from F.Y. B.Sc. and at least 22 credits from S.Y. B.Sc.

6. Completion of Degree Course:

- 6.1 A student who earns 140 credits, shall be considered to have completed the requirements of the B. Sc. degree program and CGPA will be calculated for such student. On the basis of only 132 credits. The following percentage to grade and grade point is given in Table-3 and respective example of CGPA calculation is given in Table-4.

7. PERFORMANCE INDICES:

The semester end grade sheet will contain grades for the courses along with titles and SGPA. Final grade sheet and transcript shall contain CGPA.

- 7.1 **Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA)** -The performance of a student in a semester is indicated by a number called the Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA). The SGPA is the weighted average of the grade points obtained in all the courses, seminars and projects registered by the student during the semester.

$$SGPA = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^p C_i G_i}{\sum_{i=1}^p C_i}$$

$$SGPA = \frac{\sum \text{Grade Points Earned} \times \text{Credits for each course}}{\text{Total Credits}}$$

For Example: suppose in a given semester a student has registered for five courses having credits C1, C2, C3, C4, C5 and his / her grade points in those courses are G1, G2, G3, G4, G5 respectively.

Then students

$$SGPA = \frac{C_1 G_1 + C_2 G_2 + C_3 G_3 + C_4 G_4 + C_5 G_5}{C_1 + C_2 + C_3 + C_4 + C_5}$$

SGPA is calculated up to two decimal places by rounding off.

- 7.2 **Course Grade Point Average (CGPA)**- The CGPA is the weighted average of the grade points obtained in all the courses (Theory/term work/practical/oral/presentation) of first semester to sixth semester for the students admitted in the First year and third to sixth semester for the students directly admitted at Second year. It is calculated in the same manner as the SGPA.

In case of a student passing a failed course or in case of improvement, the earlier grade would be replaced by the new grade in calculation of the SGPA and CGPA.

8. RESULT:

Based on the performance of the student in the semester examinations, the Savitribai Phule Pune University will declare the results and issue the Semester Grade sheets.

The class shall be awarded to a student on the CGPA calculated as mentioned in Rule no. 6.1. The award of the class shall be as per Table 5, and corresponding percentage calculation for the CGPA is given in Table 6, along with all details and examples.

For the calculation of Percentage from CGPA following equation can be used.

$$\% \text{ of Marks} = \begin{cases} \text{if O grade then } 20 \times \text{CGPA} - 100 \\ \text{if A+ grade then } 10 \times \text{CGPA} - 5 \\ \text{if A grade then } 10 \times \text{CGPA} - 5 \\ \text{if B+ grade then } 12 \times \text{CGPA} - 20 \\ \text{if B grade then } 5 \times \text{CGPA} + 23.75 \\ \text{if C grade then } 10 \times \text{CGPA} - 2.50 \\ \text{if D grade then } 6.6 \times \text{CGPA} + 13.6 \end{cases}$$



While declaring the result, the existing relevant ordinances are applicable. There is also a provision for verification and revaluation. In case of verification, the existing rules will be applicable. The revaluation result will be adopted if there is a change of at least 10% marks and in the grade of the course.



For grade improvement a student will have to take minimum 30% of the requisite number of credits for the concerned degree. These courses will be theory courses from the parent department. Grade improvement programme will be implemented at the end of the academic year. A student can opt for the grade improvement programme only after the declaration of the result for his/her final semester exam, i.e., at the end of the next academic year after passing the final examination and within two years of completion of the degree and only once.

B) The Examination forms be validated & inward be done by the college within stipulated time limit. Inward facility be started from first day of submission of form by the student C) The Exam fees should be deposited in the bank within 3 days after the expiry of the each last date.
3	Exam forms will be accepted only up to last date with late fee. Please note that after last date with late fee no forms will be accepted.
4	All the title of the papers may appear in the examination programme. However the question paper will be set only of those papers for which the teaching is provided in the affiliated colleges/recognized institutes/University Departments.
5	Post Graduate Departmental Examinations will be conducted by the Principals of affiliated colleges having P.G. Centers/Heads of the University Departments and Director of Recognized Institutes in such a way that, the marks of the Examinations and Departmental Courses are submitted to the University on or before the commencement of the respective examinations. No relaxation will be given in this regard.
6	The Departmental Courses and Term End Examination should be arranged by the Colleges / Departments / Institutes in such a way so that it should not clash with the dates of the University examinations.
7	All Departments of University and the courses conducted under circular No. 125 have to declare the results of every examination conducted by them within 30 days from the last date of examinations of per course.
8	For Handicapped, Blind and Learning Disabled Students: The Senior Supervisors/Principal/Director of the concerned examination centre is authorized to make the appointment of a writer at an examination for Handicapped, Blind and Learning Disabled Students. The writer to be appointed must not have passed the examination at which he is appointed to work for the examination. The concerned writer should not be first relative with Examinee, i.e. Mother-Father, Sister-Brother, Paternal and Maternal Uncle. And also authorized to sanction additional Twenty minutes for per one hour question paper to handicapped, blind and learning disabled students. However students will have to submit the medical certificate of endorsing Civil Surgeon. An application of the student must be received through the Principal/Director to the Senior Supervisor concerned. Answer-Scripts of learning disabled students be submitted to CAP Centre in separate envelop.

9	The Senior Supervisors/ Principal/Director of the concerned examination centre is authorized to make the appointment of a writer at an examination for a candidate who, in their opinion, is unable to appear for the examination on medical grounds. The writer to be appointed, must not have passed the examination at which he is appointed to work for the examination. The concerned writer should not be first relative with Examinee, i.e. Mother-Father, Sister-Brother, Paternal and Maternal Uncle. The concerned Examinee must submit medical certificate of endorsing Civil Surgeon. The Senior Supervisor shall make a separate seating arrangement for the writer.
10	The Principals of all Affiliated Colleges/Directors of the Recognized Institutes/Heads of the University Departments are requested to follow the procedure laid down by the Finance Department of University from time to time, for the purpose of following the procedure for filling the examination forms.
11	They are further requested to ensure that the examination forms are retained at the concerned examination centre for verification to University office as and when asked.
