



Date :28 Feb 2020


February 28th is celebrated as National Science Day all over the country, commemorating the discovery of the Raman Effect by C.V. Raman, for which he was awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930. On this occasion of Science Day, our department of physics has arranged the visit for M.Sc. students to Giant Metrewave Radio Telescope (GMRT), Khodad on 28th Feb, 2020. Five teaching staff with 21 students from M.Sc. Part- I had participated in that visit. We started our journey from our college on 28th Feb, 2020 at 07.30 a.m. We reached there at around 11.30 a.m. Giant Metrewave Radio Telescope (GMRT) is a telescope built and operated by National Centre for Radio Astronomy (NCRA), Pune of Tata Institute of Fundamental Research (TIFR), Mumbai and situated at Narayangoan, Tal - Junnar, Dist – Pune, PIN- 410 504 which is 80 km away to the north of Pune.

GMRT consists of 30 fully steerable gigantic parabolic dishes of 45m diameter each spread over distances of up to 25 km. Although the prime activity at NCRA and GMRT is to carry out frontline research in radio astronomy and astrophysics, and develop the good instrumentation for this purpose, NCRA and GMRT observatory also have programs to popularize science and technology among the general public, especially the student community. We visited this program which consists of a grand Science Exhibition, where children from the schools and colleges exhibit their science projects. In addition, there are exhibitions illustrating astronomical themes and concepts, exciting results obtained with the GMRT, various subsystems of GMRT and illustrative models which we found most interesting. We enjoyed the live demonstrations from various research institutes and science popularization groups, as well as teaching institutions such as the University of Pune and various national laboratories.

We also interacted with well-known scientists who solved our all queries regarding the GMRT project and also guided us on Careers and research in Astronomy. Then having really inspiring experience, our group reached to Hadapsar, Pune at 8.00 p.m. on the same day.


